Summary of Legislation

This bill removes the requirement for health facility licenses issued by the Department of Public Health and Environment to include the signature of the president of the State Board of Health, the attestation of the board secretary, and the state board's seal.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Removing obsolete language for health facility licensing has no affect on operations in the Department of Public Health and Environment. Therefore the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
