**Bill Topic:** **CLARIFY DOUBLE ELECTRICAL INSPECTION FEES IF LATE**

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** The bill clarifies statute related to electrical inspection fees and is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local government.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

## Summary of Legislation

Under current law, Section 12-115-121 (1), C.R.S. allows the State Electrical Board to set electrical inspection fees, and Section 12-115-121 (3), C.R.S. allows the fee to be doubled if the permit application is not filed prior to the start of electrical work. The bill adds a reference to subsection (3) in subsection (1).

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Because the bill only clarifies statutory references and does not change the fee or how it is assessed, it does not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state or local government agency.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
