AUTHORITY FOR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO CHALLENGE **Bill Topic:**

FEDERALLY REVIEWED MERGERS UNDER STATE ANTITRUST LAW

No fiscal impact. This bill authorizes the Attorney General to challenge certain Summary of **Fiscal Impact:**

business mergers or acquisitions under state antitrust statutes. Any such challenges will be conducted within existing appropriations, so the bill is assessed as having no

fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the Attorney General cannot challenge any merger or acquisition under the Colorado Antitrust Act of 1992 that has been reviewed and not challenged by a federal department, agency, or commission. This bill ends that restriction.

Summary of Assessment

This bill provides discretion to the Attorney General to act in certain situations that are prohibited under current law. As such, any review of such mergers or acquisitions will be prioritized by the Attorney General to be conducted within existing appropriations. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact on the Department of Law.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
