Bill Topic: **LIMIT LIABILITY FOR FOOD DONATIONS TO NONPROFITS**

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill extends food donation limited immunity protections from civil and criminal liability to correctional facilities, hospitals, school districts, and farmers allowing one or more individuals to glean on their property. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, retail food establishments and nonprofit organizations have limited immunity protections from civil or criminal liability when they donate food for distribution to individuals who are needy or poor. This bill extends this limited immunity protection to correctional facilities, hospitals, school districts, and farmers allowing one or more individuals to glean on their property. The bill also encourages retail food establishments, correctional facilities, hospitals, and school districts to donate wholesome food to nonprofit organizations

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill has no impact on the bed or operational costs of the Department of Corrections and local school districts, and therefore will result in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 26, 2020, and takes effect on September 14, 2020, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
