Bill Topic: CHILDREN'S HABILITATION RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM RULES

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill authorizes the Medical Services Board to adopt rule changes to the Children's Habilitation Residential Program in advance of federal **Fiscal Impact:**

approval of a waiver. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill authorizes the Medical Services Board in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing to adopt rules for the Children's Habilitation Residential Program to implement changes proposed in a waiver submitted to the federal government, provided that the rules are not effective until the waiver is approved.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

By allowing rules to be adopted in advance of anticipated waiver approvals, the bill affects only the timing of rulemaking. It will not affect state or local revenue or expenditures, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
