CHANGE MANAGEMENT OF STATE CONVENTION DISPLAY SPACE **Bill Topic:**

The bill transfers management of the display space in the Colorado Convention Center from the Department of Personnel and Administration to the Office of Economic Development and International Trade. It increases state workload in

FY 2020-21.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

Currently, the Department of Personnel and Administration (DPA) manages a display space at the Colorado Convention Center to be used by counties, municipalities, state agencies, and private organizations to promote tourism, education, business, and agricultural activities in Colorado. The bill transfers management of the display space from DPA to the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT), and adds outdoor recreation to the list of activities promoted by the display space. It also authorizes OEDIT to convene an advisory group to help manage the display space.

State Expenditures

In FY 2020-21, the bill increases workload in OEDIT to establish a stakeholder advisory group to help manage the display space. This workload is expected to be minimal and no appropriation is required.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
