CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
STATE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Appropriation to the department of state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019.** In Session Laws of Colorado 2019, section 2 of chapter 454, (SB 19-207), **amend** Part XX (3) and the affected totals, as Part XX (3) and the affected totals are amended by section 14 of chapter 326 (HB 20-1360), Session Laws of Colorado 2020, as follows:
