
A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING ALCOHOL BEVERAGES PURCHASED FOR THE PURPOSE OF
102	A SPECIAL EVENT HELD AT A CLUB LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOL
103	BEVERAGES BY THE DRINK TO CLUB MEMBERS FOR
104	CONSUMPTION ON THE CLUB PREMISES.

Bill Summary

The bill authorizes a person with a club license (licensee) that allows the sale of alcohol beverages by the drink to members of the club and their guests for consumption on the premises of the club to:





- Commingle any donated alcohol beverages with the licensee's inventory of alcohol beverages; and
- Retain and sell donated alcohol beverages that remain on the licensee's premises after a special event.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

3 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 44-5-109 as 4 follows:

44-5-109. Alcohol beverages obtained for a special event authority of club licensee to commingle with inventory. IF A PERSON
LICENSED UNDER SECTION 44-3-418 PURCHASES ALCOHOL BEVERAGES
FROM A WHOLESALER FOR PURPOSES OF A SPECIAL EVENT HELD ON THE
LICENSEE'S PREMISES, THE LICENSEE IS NOT REQUIRED TO STORE THE
ALCOHOL BEVERAGES PURCHASED FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT SEPARATELY
FROM THE LICENSEE'S INVENTORY.

12 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -13 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following 14 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the 15 general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant 16 to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an 17 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, 18 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the 19 general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take 20 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the 21 governor.

(2) This act applies to special event permits issued on or after theapplicable effective date of this act.
