CONCERNING EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF "ELECTRONIC MONITORING SERVICES" TO INCLUDE REMOTE SUPPORTS FOR THE HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES WAIVER FOR THE ELDERLY, BLIND, AND DISABLED.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-6-303, **amend** (9) as follows:

25.5-6-303. Definitions. As used in this part 3, unless the context otherwise requires:

(9) "Electronic monitoring services" means electronic equipment or adaptations OR OTHER REMOTE SUPPORTS that are related to an eligible

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
