Summary of Legislation

The bill clarifies that off-highway vehicles registered or titled in other states or jurisdictions are subject to the same restrictions on public streets, roads, or highways as those that are registered or titled in Colorado.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill clarifies statute and does not expand or create any new restrictions or criminal penalties. It will not affect state or local revenue and expenditures; therefore, this bill has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 7, 2021.
