Summary of Legislation

The bill repeals the Capitol Dome Restoration Fund and related parts of statute.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The project has been completed and other related parts of statute repealed in 2015. Eliminating this outdated language results in no change to any state or local government revenue or expenditures.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 20, 2021, and takes effect on September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
