Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$63,134 cash funds from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies and reappropriating \$15,951 to the Department of Law for FY 2021-22. This provision assumes that the Department of Regulatory Agencies will require an additional 0.5 FTE and the Department of Law will require an additional 0.1 FTE.
