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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING A DUTY OF THE DIVISION OF FIRE PREVENTION AND**  
102                    **CONTROL TO CONDUCT WILDLAND FIRE INVESTIGATIONS, AND,**  
103                    **IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

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**Bill Summary**

The bill establishes that conducting investigations of wildland fires in the state is a duty of the division of fire prevention and control within the department of public safety and makes an appropriation to fund such investigations.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1203.5,  
3 **amend** (3) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-1203.5. Powers and duties of director - report.**

5 (3) Commencing in 2014, the director shall report annually to the  
6 wildfire matters review committee created in section 2-3-1602 C.R.S.,  
7 regarding the current nature and magnitude of the state's wildfire  
8 WILDLAND FIRE situation, THE NUMBER OF WILDLAND FIRE  
9 INVESTIGATIONS THE DIVISION CONDUCTED IN THE PRECEDING CALENDAR  
10 YEAR, AND THE STATUS OF OR, IF THE INVESTIGATION IS COMPLETED, THE  
11 RESULTS OF, EACH INVESTIGATION, the status of wildfire WILDLAND FIRE  
12 preparedness and prescribed burns in the state, including available  
13 resources, and the challenges to addressing the state's wildfire WILDLAND  
14 FIRE threat. The report required by this subsection (3) is exempt from the  
15 automatic expiration described in section 24-1-136 (11).

16 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add**  
17 24-33.5-1236 as follows:

18 24-33.5-1236. Fire origin and cause investigation fund -

19 created. (1) THERE IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY THE  
20 FIRE ORIGIN AND CAUSE INVESTIGATION FUND, REFERRED TO IN THIS  
21 SECTION AS THE "FUND". THE FUND CONSISTS OF ANY MONEY THAT MAY  
22 BE APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ALL PRIVATE  
23 AND PUBLIC MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS  
24 THAT ARE TRANSMITTED TO THE STATE TREASURER AND CREDITED TO THE  
25 FUND, AND MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION  
26 (4) OF THIS SECTION. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST

1 AND INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN  
2 THE FUND TO THE FUND. THE MONEY IN THE FUND IS CONTINUOUSLY  
3 APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS  
4 SECTION.

5 (2) THE DIVISION SHALL USE THE MONEY IN THE FUND TO:

6 (a) FUND STATE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING SUPPORT TO  
7 LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN INVESTIGATING THE CAUSE AND ORIGIN OF  
8 FIRES;

9 (b) REIMBURSE FIRE INVESTIGATORS WHO ARE NOT EMPLOYED BY  
10 THE DIVISION BUT ARE ACTING UNDER THE DIRECTION AND COORDINATION  
11 OF THE DIVISION AT AN ESTABLISHED RATE FOR ASSISTING IN FIRE CAUSE  
12 AND ORIGIN INVESTIGATIONS OUTSIDE OF JURISDICTION;

13 (c) ENSURE FIRE ORIGIN AND CAUSE DATA IS ACCURATELY  
14 COLLECTED, ANALYZED, AND DISSEMINATED; AND

15 (d) UTILIZE THE DATA COLLECTED AS SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION  
16 TO MORE EFFECTIVELY PREVENT OR MITIGATE FUTURE FIRES.

17 (3) THE DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT RULES AS NECESSARY TO  
18 IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

19 (4) ON JULY 1, 2022, AND ON EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER, , THE  
20 STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THREE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE  
21 GENERAL FUND TO THE FUND FOR USE BY THE DIVISION AS SET FORTH IN  
22 SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION.

23 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
25 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
