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Bill Topic: VACANCY COMMITTEE SELECTION

Summary Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill requires that vacancy committees include the members of a jurisdiction's central committee. The bill has no impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the reengrossed bill.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, a political party central committee of a jurisdiction is required to appoint a vacancy committee, or if none is appointed, the central committee serves as the vacancy committee. This bill specifies that vacancy committees, at a minimum, include the members of the jurisdiction's central committee. In addition, the bill applies a similar standard for vacancy committees for the office of county commissioner and the State Board of Education.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

While governed by state law, the creation and operation of vacancy committees is managed by political parties. Thus, this bill does not impact the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state agencies or local government and it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed. It applies to vacancies occurring on or after this effective date.
