### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires that the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) distribute supplemental payments to approved facility schools, and appropriates \$5.1 million in FY 2022-23 for this purpose. CDE must determine the method of distributing the payments, and distribute the funding by June 30, 2023. The supplemental payments must be above the current daily per pupil revenue rate for FY 2022-23.

### **State Expenditures**

In FY 2022-23 only, the bill increases state expenditures by \$5.1 million for supplemental payments to approved facility schools. CDE will incur a minimal workload increase to distribute the payments.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 25, 2022 and takes effect August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.

### **State Appropriations**

In FY 2022-23, the bill includes an appropriation of \$5,134,000 from the State Education Fund to the Colorado Department of Education.
