This bill adds Douglas County to the list of counties represented in the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District, which will minimally increase state and local government workload.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill adds Douglas County to the list of represented counties on the Board of Directors of the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District. The Governor makes appointments to the board.

State Expenditures

The Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions will have a minimal workload increase to make the required appointment under the bill. This work can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Local Government

The bill will increase the workload for a representative from Douglas County to serve on the board of directors.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 15, 2022, and takes effect on August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
