Summary of Fiscal Impact. The bill expands the scope of the Water Resources Review Committee to include agriculture issues. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state and local governments.

Summary of Legislation

The bill expands the scope of the Water Resources Review Committee to include identifying, monitoring, and addressing agriculture issues, and renames it the Water Resources and Agriculture Review Committee.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

While the bill expands the scope of policy issues the committee is directed to consider, it makes no change to committee membership nor the number of meetings the committee will hold. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
