Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The Colorado youth advisory council (advisory committee) is set to repeal September 1, 2023. The bill implements the department of regulatory agencies' recommendation to continue the advisory committee indefinitely.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1304, amend

(4)(a) and (6)(b) as follows:

2-2-1304. Duties - meetings - community outreach
designation of organization to accept donations - authority to

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designation of organization to accept donations - authority to contract.

(4) (a) On or before September 1, 2013, and every third September 1 thereafter THROUGH SEPTEMBER 1, 2019, the council shall, in conjunction with the director of the legislative council, use a request for proposal process to contract with and designate one or more nonprofit organizations to provide staffing and operational assistance and to serve as the custodian of moneys MONEY donated to the council through the designated organization. THE CONTRACTOR SELECTED FOLLOWING THE 2019 REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCESS SHALL, PURSUANT TO ONE OR MORE CONTRACTS, PROVIDE SUCH STAFFING, OPERATIONAL, AND CUSTODIAN SERVICES THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023. THEREAFTER, THE COUNCIL SHALL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, ON OR BEFORE APRIL 30, 2023, AND, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4)(a), ON OR BEFORE EVERY SECOND APRIL 15 THEREAFTER, USE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCESS TO CONTRACT WITH AND DESIGNATE ONE OR MORE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE SUCH STAFFING, OPERATIONAL, AND CUSTODIAN SERVICES. THE TERM OF EACH CONTRACT ENTERED INTO FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2023, IS TWO STATE FISCAL YEARS; EXCEPT THAT ANY SUCH CONTRACT MAY BE EXTENDED FOR ONE ADDITIONAL TWO-YEAR TERM. IF A CONTRACT IS EXTENDED, THE REQUEST

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1	FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE NEXT CONTRACT MUST BE ISSUED ON OR BEFORE
2	THE APRIL 15 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE EXPIRATION OF THE
3	EXTENSION TERM. The designated organization shall not be the custodian
4	of any moneys MONEY appropriated by the state and credited to the fund
5	created in section 2-2-1306. The designated organization is authorized to
6	expend any moneys MONEY it receives as is necessary for the operation
7	of the council and may solicit and accept monetary and in-kind gifts,
8	grants, and donations used to further the council's duties and
9	responsibilities. Any such moneys MONEY donated or awarded to the
10	designated organization for the benefit of the council are IS not subject to
11	appropriation by the general assembly. Any such moneys MONEY obtained
12	by the council or the designated organization and not in the fund that are
13	IS unexpended and unencumbered at the time the council is dissolved
14	shall be distributed according to appropriate federal and state laws
15	governing nonprofit organizations. If a different nonprofit or private
16	organization is subsequently designated as the custodian of donated
17	moneys MONEY in accordance with this paragraph (a), any moneys MONEY
18	that are IS unexpended and unencumbered at the time of the change in
19	designation shall be promptly transferred by the previously designated
20	organization to the newly designated organization.
21	(6) (b) On or before April 30, 2021, APRIL 20, 2023, and on or
22	before April 30 APRIL 1 of each year thereafter, the council shall select
23	five members to serve as nonvoting members of the review committee
24	during the subsequent legislative interim.
25	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1305.5, amend
26	(3)(b) and (4) as follows:
27	2-2-1305.5. Colorado youth advisory council review committee

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1	- created. (3) (b) On or before April 30, 2021, APRIL 20, 2023, and on or
2	before April 30 APRIL 1 of each year thereafter, the chair of the legislative
3	council shall appoint the member serving pursuant to subsection (2)(a)(II)
4	of this section to serve during the subsequent legislative interim.
5	(4) In odd-numbered years, the speaker of the house of
6	representatives shall appoint the chair of the review committee and the
7	president of the senate shall appoint the vice-chair. In even-numbered
8	years, the president of the senate shall appoint the chair and the speaker
9	of the house of representatives shall appoint the vice-chair. The
10	appointing authorities shall make the appointments on or before April 30
11	APRIL 20, 2023, AND ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1 of each year THEREAFTER.
12	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1301.5, amend
13	(4) as follows:
14	2-2-1301.5. Definitions. As used in this part 13, unless the
15	context otherwise requires:
16	(4) "Review committee" means the REPRESENTATIVE HUGH
17	McKean Colorado youth advisory council review committee created in
18	section 2-2-1305.5.
19	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1305.5, amend
20	(1) as follows:
21	2-2-1305.5. Representative Hugh McKean Colorado youth
22	advisory council review committee - created. (1) There is created in
23	the legislative branch the REPRESENTATIVE HUGH MCKEAN Colorado
24	youth advisory council review committee to review the council's work
25	and to recommend legislation regarding issues affecting Colorado youth.
26	The committee is comprised of ten members, as described in subsection
27	(2) of this section.

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1	SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 2-2-1307 as
2	follows:
3	2-2-1307. Repeal of part. This part 13 is repealed, effective
4	September 1, 2023 SEPTEMBER 1, 2028. Prior to the repeal of this part 13,
5	the council must be reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203.
6	SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
7	(14)(a)(VI); and add (19)(a)(II) as follows:
8	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
9	declaration - definition - repeal. (14) (a) The following statutory
10	authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for
11	repeal on September 1, 2023:
12	(VI) The Colorado youth advisory council created in section
13	2-2-1302;
14	(19) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated
15	advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2028:
16	(II) THE COLORADO YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL CREATED IN

18	SECTION 7. Appropriation. For the 2023-24 state fiscal year,
19	\$50,000 is appropriated to the youth advisory council cash fund created
20	in section 2-2-1306, C.R.S. This appropriation is from the general fund.
21	The legislative department is responsible for the accounting related to this
22	appropriation.
23	SECTION 8. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby
24	finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
25	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
