#### **Bill Summary**

The bill creates the urgent incident response fund (fund). Money in the fund is continuously appropriated to the division of homeland HOUSE Amended 2nd Reading April 20, 2023 security and emergency management in the department of public safety to reimburse state agencies and local governments for the costs of responding to urgent incidents that do not rise to the level of disasters or emergencies.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-33.5-1623 as 3 follows: 4 24-33.5-1623. Urgent incident response fund - created -5 definitions. (1) As used in this section, unless the context 6 OTHERWISE REQUIRES: 7 (a) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION. 8 (b) "DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND 9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1603. 10 11 "FUND" MEANS THE URGENT INCIDENT RESPONSE FUND (c)12 CREATED IN SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION. 13 (d)"LOCAL GOVERNMENT" MEANS A CITY, COUNTY, 14 MUNICIPALITY, CITY AND COUNTY, TRIBAL GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER 15 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE THAT IS NOT A STATE AGENCY. 16 (e) "STATE AGENCY" MEANS ANY DEPARTMENT, DIVISION, 17 COMMISSION, COUNCIL, BOARD, BUREAU, COMMITTEE, OFFICE, AGENCY, OR 18 OTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OF THE STATE. 19 (2) THE URGENT INCIDENT RESPONSE FUND IS HEREBY CREATED IN 20 THE STATE TREASURY. THE FUND CONSISTS OF ANY MONEY THAT THE 21 GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY APPROPRIATE OR TRANSFER TO THE FUND AND 22 ANY MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS. THE 23 DIRECTOR MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS

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FROM PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SOURCES FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
 THE DIRECTOR SHALL TRANSMIT ALL MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS,
 GRANTS, OR DONATIONS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT
 THE MONEY TO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL
 INTEREST AND INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF
 MONEY IN THE FUND TO THE FUND.

(3) MONEY IN THE FUND IS ANNUALLY APPROPRIATED TO THE
DIVISION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING STATE AGENCIES AND LOCAL
GOVERNMENTS FOR THE COSTS OF RESPONDING TO URGENT INCIDENTS
THAT DO NOT RISE TO THE LEVEL OF DISASTERS AS DEFINED IN SECTION
24-33.5-703 (3) OR EMERGENCIES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 24-33.5-703
(3.5). THE DIVISION SHALL NOT EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND:

(a) FOR ANY OF THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN SECTION 24-33.5-702;
(b) TO REIMBURSE STATE AGENCIES OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FOR
THE COSTS OF RESPONDING TO DISASTERS AS DEFINED IN SECTION
24-33.5-703 (3) OR EMERGENCIES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 24-33.5-703
(3.5); OR

18 (c) FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESPONDING TO A DISASTER EMERGENCY
 19 DECLARED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-33.5-704.

(4) AFTER REIMBURSING A STATE AGENCY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT
FOR THE COSTS OF RESPONDING TO AN URGENT INCIDENT, THE DIVISION
SHALL PUBLISH, AT A MINIUM, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE
DIVISION'S WEBSITE: THE STATE AGENCY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT
RECEIVING THE REIMBURSEMENT, THE AMOUNT OF THE REIMBURSEMENT,
AND THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE STATE AGENCY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT
WILL USE THE REIMBURSEMENT.

27 (5) THE DIVISION SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO ESTABLISH A

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PROCESS FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND STATE AGENCIES TO RECEIVE
 REIMBURSEMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION. AT
 MINIMUM, THE PROCESS MUST INCLUDED CRITERIA FOR:

- 4 (a) APPLYING FOR A REIMBURSEMENT;
- 5 (b) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF A
  6 REIMBURSEMENT; AND
- 7 (c) The distribution and receipt of an approved 8 reimbursement.

9 **SECTION 2.** Appropriation. (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal 10 year, \$1,000,000 is appropriated to the urgent incident response fund 11 created in section 24-33.5-1623 (2), C.R.S. This appropriation is from the 12 general fund. The department of public safety is responsible for the 13 accounting related to this appropriation.

(2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$1,000,000 is appropriated
to the department of public safety for use by the division of homeland
security and emergency management. This appropriation is from
reappropriated funds in the urgent incident response fund under
subsection (1) of this section. To implement this act, the division may use
the appropriation for urgent incident response.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
