A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING A JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING ABOUT A**
102 **DISASTER EMERGENCY DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR.**

Bill Summary

Under existing law, the executive committee of the legislative council and the joint budget committee (committees) must hold a joint meeting in March, August, and December if there has been a declaration of a disaster emergency by the governor since the first day of the month for the last required meeting.

The bill eliminates the requirement that the committees meet

during those months. Instead, the committees are required to meet upon a written request of a majority of the members of the committees if there has been a disaster declaration by the governor since the last meeting.

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1801, **amend** (2)

4 **2-3-1801. Legislative committees to receive information from**
5 **the executive branch during a declared disaster emergency -**
6 **definition.** (2) ~~Each year, The committees shall hold a joint meeting~~
7 ~~during the months of March, August, and December~~ IF A MAJORITY OF
8 THE TOTAL MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEES SUBMITS A WRITTEN
9 REQUEST TO HOLD A JOINT MEETING AND if there has been a declaration
10 of a disaster emergency by the governor under section 24-33.5-704 (4),

16 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
