### HB 23-1107

#### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill continues the Crime Victim Service Fund indefinitely, which is currently scheduled to repeal on July 1, 2027. The bill also requires a transfer of \$3.0 million from the General Fund to the State Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Services Fund in the Department of Human Services.

#### **State Transfers**

In FY 2023-24, the bill transfers \$3.0 million from the General Fund to the State Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Services Fund.

#### **State Expenditures**

Starting in FY 2023-24, cash fund expenditures in the DHS will increase to provide funding to domestic abuse programs. As the fund is continuously appropriated, expenditures may occur over multiple fiscal years.

#### **Effective Date**

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 25, 2023.
