**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$132,300 from the DRIVES Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2022-23. Of this amount, \$19,800 is reappropriated to the Governor’s Office for the provision of information technology services. The revised fiscal note reduces the necessary appropriation in the bill by \$71,190 and reflects refinements in the Department of Revenue's understanding and planned implementation of the bill.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.002** Staff has prepared amendment J.002 (attached) to reduce the existing appropriation in the bill to \$61,110 cash funds from the Colorado DRIVES Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2023-24. Of this amount, \$8,910 is reappropriated to the Governor's Office for the provision of information technology services. This amendment aligns with the revised fiscal note, dated 03/09/23.
