**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2023-24. This bill does not require a General Fund appropriation, but does authorize the State Treasurer to expend \$250,000 General Fund annually beginning in FY 2023-24, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2023-24 appropriations by this amount.
