#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$40,203,671 cash funds from the State Education Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2023-24.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### State Education Fund

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2023-24 based on the March 2023 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2023-24 budget package a total of \$40,203,671 cash funds from the State Education Fund to be appropriated for legislation associated with special education. That amount includes:

- \$39,703,671 specifically for the implementation of this bill; and
- \$500,000 to support potential statutory changes associated with translation services for students with individualized education programs.
