#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriations clause that provides \$18,780,654 cash funds from the State Education Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2023-24. The appropriations clause also eliminates a FY 2023-24 Long Bill appropriation to the Department of Education for facility school administration of \$216,625 reappropriated funds. The provisions also state that the appropriations are based on assumptions that the Department will require a net increase of 4.1 FTE.
