Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$7,345,507 total funds to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing in FY 2023-24, including \$1,439,499 General Fund, \$446,651 cash funds from the Healthcare Affordability and Sustainability Fee Cash Fund, and an anticipated \$5,459,357 federal funds.

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2023-24 based on the March 2023 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2023-24 budget package \$1,439,499 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.
