The Fiscal Note identifies a 50-50 split amount for the purchase of legal services for the Office and the Judicial Department to memorialize the intention of the appropriation. The appropriation included in the bill combines these amounts in a single appropriation to the Judicial Department, reducing the FTE reflected for the Department of Law from 0.6 to 0.5 FTE. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the appropriation included in the bill is consistent with the appropriation amount identified in the Fiscal Note.

Amendments in This Packet for Consideration by Appropriations Committee

Amendment Description

Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$508,289 General Fund,

including:

- \$746,909 to the Office of Administrative Services for Independent Agencies in the Judicial Department;
- \$100,453 to the Judicial Department for the purchase of legal services for the Office and the Department; and
- decreases the Long Bill appropriation to the Commission on Judicial Discipline by \$339,073.

The appropriation clause also reappropriates \$100,453 to the Department of Law and is based on the assumption that the Office will require an additional 6.0 FTE, the Department of Law will require an additional 0.5 FTE, and the related FTE for the Commission on Judicial Discipline will be decreased by 4.0 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2023-24 based on the March 2023 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2023-24 budget package \$508,289 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.
