The Senate adopted two amendments to the bill on second reading (04/14/23). With these amendments, the bill now requires the Executive Committee and the Joint Budget Committee to hold a joint meeting if any member of the committees submits to the Chairs of the two committees and the Governor a written request to hold a joint meeting. A request for a joint meeting may be waived by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the total membership of the committees. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that this amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of the bill.
