### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$30,260 from the Healthcare Affordability and Sustainability Fee Cash Fund to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2023-24. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.8 FTE and the Department will receive \$30,259 federal funds to implement the act.
