Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies

in its sunset review of the Colorado state advisory council for parent involvement in education (advisory council) by continuing the advisory council indefinitely.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 3 (15)(a)(VII) as follows: 4 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 5 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (15) (a) The following statutory 6 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 7 repeal on September 1, 2024: 8 (VII) The Colorado state advisory council for parent involvement 9 in education created in section 22-7-303; 10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 22-7-306. 11 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 14 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 15 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 16 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 17 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 18 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
