1 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the*
2 *Seventy-fourth General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

3 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 25,
4 **amend** (a), (c), and (k)(1) as follows:

19 MAY BE NECESSARY, AND THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEES
20 SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE APPROPRIATE APPOINTING
21 AUTHORITY. Every member of the House of Representatives,
22 except the Speaker, the majority leader, and the minority leader of
23 the House of Representatives, shall be appointed to at least one of
24 such committees.
