1 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the*  
2 *Seventy-fourth General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

3 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 25,  
4 **amend** (f.5)(3) as follows:

5 **25. Committees**

6 (f.5) (3) If the chair receives a complaint against a member of the  
7 House of Representatives or a partisan staff person of the  
8 House of Representatives under the Workplace Harassment  
9 Policy, the chair shall convene a meeting of the House  
10 Workplace Harassment Committee to consider the  
11 complaint and shall proceed in accordance with the  
12 Workplace Harassment Policy. Pursuant to the Workplace  
13 Harassment Policy and section 24-6-402 (3)(a)(III),
