#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The reengrossed bill includes a provision that appropriates \$280,928 General Fund to the Department of Early Childhood and assumes the Department will require an additional 2.7 FTE.

# **Points to Consider**

## General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$280,928 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$63.1 million set aside by the same amount.
