## AN ACT

CONCERNING A TRANSFER TO THE PROCUREMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CASH FUND.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-48.5-121, **amend** (8)(a)(I)(A) as follows:

- **24-48.5-121.** Procurement technical assistance program fund legislative declaration definitions. (8) Fund. (a) The procurement technical assistance cash fund is created in the state treasury. The fund consists of:
- (I) (A) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (8)(a)(I)(B) of this section, two hundred twenty thousand dollars that the state treasurer is required to transfer from the general fund to the fund on July 1, 2015, and July 1 of the next nine NINETEEN years thereafter, plus any additional amount the general assembly provides pursuant to subsection (4)(b) of this section.
- **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.
