101	CONCERNING ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT FOR ANNUAL
102	REPRINTING OF LAWS CONCERNING EDUCATION, AND, IN
103	CONNECTION THEREWITH, REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill eliminates the requirement that the commissioner of education annually reprint and distribute laws enacted by the general assembly that concern education.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-112, repeal
3	(1)(i) as follows:
4	22-2-112. Commissioner - duties - report - legislative
5	declaration. (1) Subject to the supervision of the state board, the
6	commissioner has the following duties:
7	(i) To cause to be reprinted annually laws enacted by the general
8	assembly concerning education, in accordance with the provisions of
9	section 24-1-136, C.R.S., and to furnish copies thereof to interested
10	persons. All publishing costs therefor shall be paid out of the state public
11	school fund pursuant to section 22-54-114 (5).
12	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-54-114, repeal (5)
13	as follows:
14	22-54-114. State public school fund. (5) All publishing costs
15	associated with the annual printing of the laws enacted by the general
16	assembly concerning education shall be paid out of the state public school
17	fund.
18	SECTION 3. Appropriation - adjustments to 2025 long bill. To
19	implement this act, the cash funds appropriation from the state public
20	school fund created in section 22-54-114 (1), C.R.S., made in the annual
21	general appropriation act for the 2025-26 state fiscal year to the
22	department of education for use by management and administration for
23	reprinting and distributing laws concerning education is decreased by
24	\$35,480.
25	SECTION 4. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2025.
26	SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
27	determines and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
