2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal article 80 of

4	SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2025 long bill. To
5	implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual
6	general appropriation act for the 2025-26 state fiscal year to the
7	department of higher education for use by the Colorado commission or
8	higher education and higher education special purpose programs for the
9	inclusive higher education grant program is decreased by \$450,000.
10	SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2025.
11	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly finds

14	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
