### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriations clause that reduces appropriations by \$1.3 million total funds for FY 2025-26, including \$150,000 General Fund in the Department of Early Childhood and \$1.2 million reappropriated funds in the Department of Human Services.

## **General Fund Impact**

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2025-26 budget package a reduction of \$150,000 General Fund appropriations to be included in this bill.
