

State Scholarship Program

FREE COLLEGE FOR COLORADO

The purpose of this initiative is to create a scholarship for all Colorado citizens that would cover the costs associated with attending any Colorado community college or public university.

The scholarship would cover:

- The cost of tuition, lab fees, and required books & equipment for **full-time and part-time** students.
- The cost of on-campus room & board for **full-time** students from families making **less than \$130,000/year**.
- A maximum amount of 150 semester credit hours per student.
- **Only the difference** between a student's existing financial aid - such as grants and scholarships - and the remaining costs associated with going to school.

Qualifications for the scholarship would be:

- Must have been a citizen of Colorado for at least one full year before the first day of classes.
- Must not currently possess a Bachelor's Degree or higher.
- Must take courses to stay on a degree path.
- Must maintain the GPA necessary to stay in school.
- No age-based restrictions.
- Graduates must stay in Colorado for the same number of years they received funding.
