**Article 16—Farm Products and Farm Commodity Warehouses**

Jery Payne explained the genesis of the meeting and the proposal to move Article 16 of Title 12 to Title 35, concerning agriculture.

Hollis Glenn confirmed that the department supports the move. He also agreed to send an email to interested stakeholders to get their feedback.

Mr. Glenn suggested three options for articles to move the program to:

- Adding a new Article 27.7 or generally within Articles 23 to 35.
- Adding a new article at the end of the title; or
- Adding a new Article 13.5

Christy Chase asked if changing the rules or forms would create a fiscal impact. Mr. Glenn replied that these updates would require minimal effort in part because these are mostly electronic. Therefore, the move should not create a fiscal impact.

Jery asked Mr. Glenn whether he thought additional meetings were useful or needed. Mr. Hollis replied that he did not foresee the need unless the industry has negative feedback.

Christy advised Mr. Glenn that any legislation would be developed during the 2017 interim and introduced during the 2018 session.
