Disclosure Process Under HB22-1348

1. Disclosers (vendors that sell to operators, operators, service providers) disclose to the COGCC information about chemical products and individual chemicals and their concentrations used in downhole oil and gas production operations.
 - i. If disclosers don't have complete information (because of trade secrets or other reasons), manufacturers share this information with the COGCC.
2. Any operator who uses chemical products downhole informs the COGCC of the product names and amounts used.
3. COGCC combines the information from 1 and 2 and generates an alphabetical list of individual chemicals and the total amounts used in the downhole operation. It displays this information on a public website. The COGCC does not include any information that associates individual chemicals with products.
4. The operator obtains the list of individual chemicals from the COGCC and shares this information with neighbors, local governments, water districts and others.
5. Based upon rules that the COGCC generates, the COGCC will share trade secret information with local governments, emergency responders, health professionals and scientists.
