## Ensures 5 Human Rights Necessary for Survival:

- The right to rest in a non-obstructive manner
- The right to shelter oneself from the elements in a non-obstructive manner
- The right to eat, share, accept, or give food in public spaces
- The right to occupy a vehicle or recreational vehicle
- The right to reasonable expectation of privacy for one's personal property
