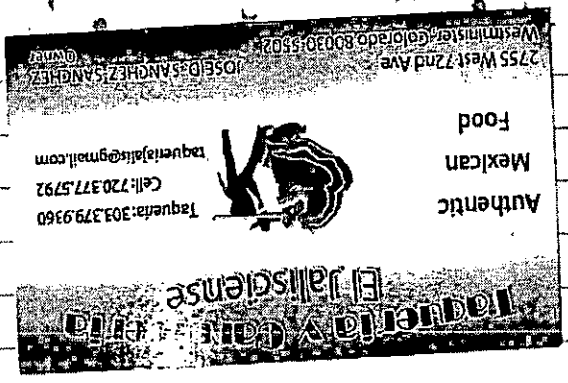
We are writing to you to inform you that we are strongly against a potential ban on styrofoam food service containers. We use these products daily to keep our prices low and our food at the correct temperature.
