SB16-065 be amended as follows:

1 Amend proposed committee amendment (SB065_L.009), page 2, after
 2 line 6 insert:

3 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-1-306, add (5)
 4 (c) (II.5); and repeal (7) (e) as follows:

5 **19-1-306. Expungement of juvenile delinquent records.**
 6 (5) (c) The court may order expunged all records in the petitioner's case
 7 in the custody of the court and any records in the custody of any other
 8 agency or official if at the hearing the court finds that:

9 (II.5) (A) THE PETITIONER HAS SATISFIED COURT-ORDERED
 10 RESTITUTION OR IS CURRENT ON A RESTITUTION REPAYMENT AGREEMENT
 11 WITH THE COURT COLLECTIONS INVESTIGATOR THAT HAS BEEN ENTERED
 12 IN THE ELECTRONIC CASE RECORD TO MAKE PAYMENT ON A SCHEDULE
 13 PURSUANT TO SECTION 16-18.5-104 (4), C.R.S.

14 (B) IF, FOLLOWING THE ENTRY OF AN ORDER OF EXPUNGEMENT
 15 UNDER THIS SECTION, A PETITIONER FAILS TO MAKE REQUIRED PAYMENTS
 16 ON A RESTITUTION REPAYMENT AGREEMENT, A COURT COLLECTIONS
 17 INVESTIGATOR MAY, FOLLOWING NOTICE TO THE PETITIONER, FILE A
 18 MOTION WITH THE COURT THAT ENTERED THE ORDER TO HAVE THE ORDER
 19 OF EXPUNGEMENT REVERSED.

20 (7) The following persons are not eligible to petition for the
 21 expungement of any juvenile record:

22 (e) ~~Any person who has failed to pay court-ordered restitution to~~
 23 ~~a victim of the offense that is the basis for the juvenile record."~~
