## SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation.HB17-1242 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike lines 17 through 24.

2 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

3 Page 12, after line 10 insert:

4 "SECTION 11. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-1-1104, **amend**  
5 (1)(b) and (2) as follows:

6 **43-1-1104. Transportation advisory committee.** (1) (b) No later  
7 than three months after May 20, 2009, the executive director, in  
8 consultation with the commission, shall appoint a ~~special interim~~ transit  
9 and rail advisory committee to specifically advise the commission and the  
10 executive director regarding the initial focus of the transit and rail  
11 division created in section 43-1-117.5 and to recommend a long-term  
12 advisory structure, including the advisory structure's purpose and role, in  
13 support of the transit and rail-related functions of the department. The  
14 ~~special interim~~ transit and rail advisory committee ~~shall~~ **MUST** include  
15 such representatives of industries and other groups interested in transit  
16 and rail issues and such other individuals as the executive director, in  
17 consultation with the commission, deems appropriate; except that the  
18 committee shall include, at a minimum, one or more:

19 (I) Representatives of transit operators;

20 (II) Representatives of class I railroads;

21 (III) Representatives of short line railroads; and

22 (IV) Representatives of entities or interest groups involved in the  
23 promotion, planning, or development of passenger rail systems;

24 (V) ADVOCATES FOR AFFORDABLE TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS;

25 (VI) PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES WHO ADVOCATE FOR PERSONS  
26 WITH ALL TYPES OF DISABILITIES; AND

27 (VIII) ADVOCATES FOR BICYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS.

28 (2) The committee shall provide advice to both the department and  
29 the commission on the needs of the transportation systems in Colorado,  
30 including but not limited to budgets, transportation improvement  
31 programs, the statewide transportation improvement program,  
32 transportation plans, and state transportation policies, and shall review  
33 and provide comment to both the department and the commission on all  
34 regional transportation plans submitted for the transportation planning  
35 regions, AND SHALL OVERSEE THE ALLOCATION OF MONEY IN THE



1 TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS ACCOUNT OF THE MULTIMODAL  
2 TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS FUND CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-1103 (1) AS  
3 SPECIFIED IN PART 11 OF ARTICLE 4 OF THIS TITLE 43. The activities of the  
4 committee shall not be construed to DO NOT constrain or replace the  
5 county hearing process."

6 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

7 Page 13, strike line 7.

8 Page 13, line 8, strike "43-4-1104 (1)," and substitute "TRANSIT AND RAIL  
9 ADVISORY COMMITTEE CREATED IN SECTION 43-1-1104 (1),".

10 Page 20, line 25, strike "43-4-1104 (3)(c)" and substitute "43-4-1104  
11 (1)(c)".

12 Page 22, line 23, strike "43-4-1104 (3)(c)" and substitute "43-4-1104  
13 (1)(c)".

14 Page 36, strike lines 18 and 19 and substitute:

15 "(3) "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE TRANSIT AND RAIL ADVISORY  
16 COMMITTEE APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 43-1-1104 (1)(b).".

17 Page 39, line 4, strike "43-4-1104 (3)(c)" and substitute "43-4-1104  
18 (1)(c)".

19 Page 41, strike lines 3 through 27.

20 Strike page 42.

21 Page 43, strike lines 1 through 5 and substitute:

22 "43-4-1104. Allocation of fund by transit and rail advisory  
23 committee - annual reporting requirement. (1) THE COMMITTEE SHALL  
24 EQUITABLY,".

25 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

26 Page 43, line 9, strike "THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTION," and  
27 substitute "THAT PURPOSE,".



- 1 Page 44, strike lines 19 through 23.
- 2 Page 45, line 19, strike "(4)(a)" and substitute "(3)(a)".
