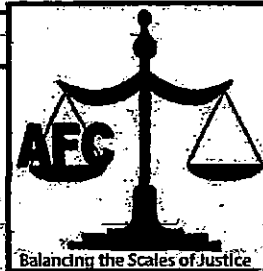

- **1231 INCARCERATED SEX OFFENDERS ARE PAST THEIR PAROLE ELIBILITY DATE.**
- **THEY MUST WAIT TO RECEIVE THE TREATMENT REQUIRED FOR THOSE WITH A SEX OFFENSE BEFORE THEY CAN BE PAROLED.**
- **THE ANNUAL COST TO KEEP THESE OFFENDERS INCARCERATED IS \$44,000,000.00**

ONE SIZE FITS ALL

- **THE 2013 EXTERNAL REVIEW AND THE 2016 AUDIT BOTH STRONGLY RECOMMEND USING RISK ASSESSMENTS TO GIVE LOW RISK OFFENDERS A SHORTER TREATMENT**
- **THIS WOULD GET MORE PEOPLE OUT AND LEAVE BEDS FOR THOSE NEEDING LONGER TREATMNT.**



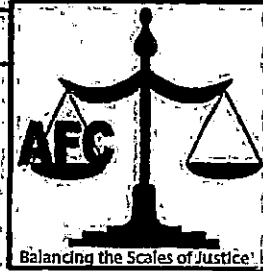

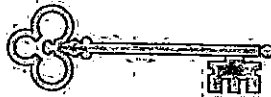

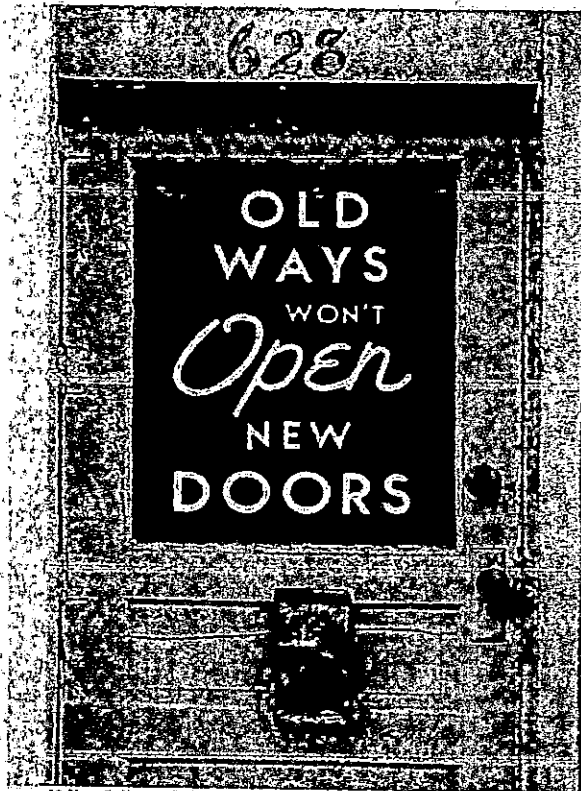


The 1998 Sex Offender Lifetime Supervision Law (LSA)
