Committee on Judiciary.

SB18-122 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, after line 19, insert:
- 2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 29-1-206, amend
- 3 (1) as follows:
- 4 **29-1-206. Law enforcement agreements.** (1) Any county in this
- 5 state that shares a common border with a county in another state, and any
- 6 municipality located in such a bordering county of this state, may enter
- 7 into an agreement with the bordering county of the other state or with a
- 8 municipality located in the bordering county of the other state to provide
- 9 for reciprocal law enforcement between the entities. The agreement shall
- 10 MUST meet the requirements of section 29-1-203 and shall MUST include,
- 11 but shall NEED not be limited to, an additional requirement that, EXCEPT
- 12 AS TO NONCERTIFIED DEPUTY SHERIFFS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 16-2.5-103
- 13 (2), any person who is assigned to law enforcement duty in this state
- 14 pursuant to such AN intergovernmental agreement and section 29-5-104
- 15 (2) shall be certified as a peace officer in the other state and shall apply
- 16 to the peace officers standards and training board created pursuant to
- 17 section 24-31-302 ~~C.R.S.~~, for recognition prior to COMMENCING an
- 18 assignment in Colorado."
- 19 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
