HB19-1312 be amended as follows:

1 Amend corrected printed bill, page 10, after line 1 insert:

2 "SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 25-4-911 as
3 follows:

4 **25-4-911. Required disclosure.** (1) A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, A
5 LICENSED ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION
6 12-36-106 (5), OR AN ADVANCE PRACTICE NURSE THAT ADMINISTERS ANY
7 IMMUNIZATION REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS PART 9 SHALL PROVIDE THE
8 FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO THE STUDENT'S PARENT OR LEGAL
9 GUARDIAN, OR THE EMANCIPATED STUDENT OR STUDENT EIGHTEEN YEARS
10 OF AGE OR OLDER, PRIOR TO ADMINISTERING AN IMMUNIZATION:

- 11 (a) THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF IMMUNIZATIONS;
- 12 (b) THE IMMUNIZATION MANUFACTURER'S PRODUCT INSERT;
- 13 (c) THE IMMUNIZATION'S EXCIPIENT AND MEDIA SUMMARY,
14 PUBLISHED BY THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
15 PREVENTION; AND
- 16 (d) HOW, AND TO WHOM, TO REPORT AN IMMUNIZATION-ADVERSE
17 EVENT.

18 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT
19 SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON ANY INFORMATIONAL
20 MATERIALS IT DEVELOPS CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS:

- 21 (a) THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF IMMUNIZATIONS;
- 22 (b) THE IMMUNIZATION MANUFACTURER'S PRODUCT INSERT;
- 23 (c) THE IMMUNIZATION'S EXCIPIENT AND MEDIA SUMMARY,
24 PUBLISHED BY THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
25 PREVENTION; AND
- 26 (d) HOW, AND TO WHOM, TO REPORT AN IMMUNIZATION-ADVERSE
27 EVENT."
