SUBJECT: Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment **HB1228_L.004**.

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment to **HB17-1228**. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

Amendment L.004 strikes everything below the enacting clause in the introduced bill and exempts from regulation under the Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act.:

- the boarding or pet handling of no more than three pet animals; and
- a pet animal care technology platform.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

The amendment eliminates the revenue and expenditures identified in the original fiscal note, leaving a minimal workload increase.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

The Inspection and Consumer Services Division of the Department of Agriculture will have a minimal workload increase to update its rules pertaining to the administration and enforcement of the Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act. This workload increase can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

HB17-1228 be amended as follows:

1 Strike the Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report, dated March
2 23, 2017, and substitute:

3 "Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
4 substitute:

5 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-80-103, **amend**
6 (2) introductory portion; and **add** (2)(k) and (2)(l) as follows:

7 **35-80-103. Scope of article.** (2) The provisions of this article
8 shall ARTICLE 80 DO not apply to:

9 (k) THE BOARDING OR PET HANDLING OF NO MORE THAN THREE PET
10 ANIMALS;

11 (l) A PET ANIMAL CARE TECHNOLOGY PLATFORM THAT IS NOT A
12 PET ANIMAL FACILITY, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 35-80-102
13 (11).

14 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."."

17 Page 1 of the printed bill, strike lines 101 and 102 and substitute
18 "CONCERNING LICENSING EXEMPTIONS RELATED TO PET ANIMAL
19 FACILITIES, INCLUDING THOSE UTILIZING TECHNOLOGY IN THEIR
20 BUSINESS MODELS."
