To the Honorable House Members,

The Colorado Cross-Disability Coalition (CCDC) supports in full the passing of HB18-1273, this bill will Protect Colorado Residents from Federal Government Overreach. In this moment of our history, it is especially important to be the Colorado that marked a crucial change in the trajectory of Civil Rights of The United States of North America, in 1978 was Colorado's Citizens with Disabilities who started one of the most important movements of the last century.

The Disability Civil Rights movement showed that discriminating on the basis of disability as any other type of discrimination such as race, ethnicity, national origin, immigration status, sexual orientation, gender identity, or religious affiliation is inhumane, therefore unacceptable.

As stated by Colorado's General Assembly in this bill:

And, we respectfully request to add “Disability” to the list of protected classes included herein.
