HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

HB18-1409 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 18 through 24 and substitute:

2       "(d) The community reentry grant program created in House Bill  
3 14-1355, enacted in 2014, uses a third-party grant administrator because  
4 this model helps engage smaller community and faith-based organizations  
5 that are usually unable to access traditional grant money despite being  
6 competent at serving their communities. The third-party grant  
7 administrator provides grantees with infrastructure, including case  
8 management, financial management, and data collection systems; helps  
9 grantees develop policies and procedures to comply with grant  
10 requirements; and offers ongoing technical assistance during the grant  
11 period.

12       (e) This third-party grant administrator model has been proven to  
13 be effective not only with regard to House Bill 14-1355 but also with  
14 regard to federal grant programs that are aimed specifically at better  
15 serving underserved communities, particularly communities of color."

16 Page 7, line 2, strike "2-3-1203." and substitute "24-34-104."

17 Page 7, strike lines 3 through 10 and substitute:

18       "**SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **add**  
19 (24)(a)(V) as follows:

20       **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**  
21 **and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative**  
22 **declaration - repeal.** (24) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,  
23 are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2023:

24       (V) THE COMMUNITY CRIME SURVIVORS GRANT PROGRAM  
25 CREATED IN SECTION 25-20.5-801;"

26 Page 7, strike lines 11 through 27.

27 Strike pages 8 and 9.

28 Page 10, strike lines 1 through 4.

29 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

30 Page 1, strike lines 102 through 104 and substitute "**GRANT PROGRAM.**".
